WHAT A WASTE

Around 90 million tonnes of construction and demolition waste are generated each year – only 50% is recycled or reclaimed! A surprisingly large proportion (34%) of the waste from a construction project is derived from materials used to package the products and materials being delivered to sites [\[1\]](#)

MINIMISE FROM START TO FINISH

Significant costs savings and other benefits can be achieved through minimising the amount of waste sent to landfill. This event will introduce you to strategies and organisations that can help you to reduce, reuse and recycle your waste.

KEEP IN LINE WITH THE LAW

Site Waste Management Plans will become a legal requirement in April 2008. A Site Waste Management Plan (SWMP) is simply a plan that details the amounts and types of wastes that will be produced on site and how they will be reused, recycled or disposed of. Learn what they are all about and ‘have a go’ at starting a plan.
